OVERALL PLAN:

- New policy
- Positive slogan
- Employees not pressured to quit tobacco products, but supported throughout their day
- Gentle reminders for visitors, no cigarette or chew
- Order set designed for inpatients

REVIEW CHANGES TO CAMPUS:

- Signage outside
- Removal of "butt huts", and receptacles campus wide
- Table top reminders, 8 x 11 counter top reminders

VISITOR/PATIENT PLAN:

- Gentle reminder cards supplied by employees for visitors wishing to smoke
- Nicotine gum and patches can be purchased in the Gift Shop
- Flyers available in all educational holders throughout the facility offering LUH, Boulder County, and Quit Line/Quit Net cessation support
- For inpatients:
  - ~ During the admission assessment, all patients are offered tobacco resources found in the admission packet.
  - ~ For any person wanting in-depth information, a packet containing specific information for their form of tobacco use is offered.
  - ~ Any inpatient requesting details and support

beyond the packet information, Laura Wesenberg (Cardiopulmonary educator) is notified and education is documented on the care map.

~ Order sets have been designed for patches, gum, and/or Bupropion for any specified patient requesting a need.
