

## Smoke-Free Housing Resources Available From GASP

### Smoke-Free Housing Library

GASP of Colorado's Smoke-Free Housing Library has more than 400 articles, presentations, sample materials, tool kits, legal opinions, trinkets, talking points, etc. on smoke-free housing available. These have been collected from other programs in the U.S. and Canada or created in or reformatted for Colorado. Some of these are posted at [www.mysmokefreehousing.org](http://www.mysmokefreehousing.org), but most of these materials are stored in files, in boxes, or in computer files that are available by e-mail or in print. The files are organized by these topics: Best Practices & Techniques; Booth Materials & Resources; Colorado Laws & Resources; Condo-HOA Resources; Editorials-Letters to the Editor; Fires-Insurance Breaks; HUD-Public-Affordable Housing Resources; Landlord Resources; Legal Resources & Documents; Media Resources; Newsletters/Apartment Publications; Policy Options & Strategies; Registry Options; SHAC/GASP Resources; Studies, Ventilation, Health Facts; Surveys; Tenant Resources & Tenant Letters; and National Web Resources.

### Legal Resources & Documents

GASP of Colorado is compiling a referral list of attorneys in Colorado who are interested in taking on cases involving secondhand smoke intrusion in multi-unit dwellings either on a pro-bono basis or on a fee basis.

### Smoke-Free Housing Databases and Data Services

GASP of Colorado has been developing a statewide contact database of housing contacts since November 2006. The contacts are available to local health departments and coalitions to help build connections or for educational purposes. The data can be sorted by city, county, or zip code and many of these contacts include e-mail addresses and/or Web site addresses. Since October 2007, GASP has also been tracking the number of multi-unit buildings that are 100% smoke-free inside which is posted at [www.mysmokefreehousing.com](http://www.mysmokefreehousing.com). Data for smoke-free buildings includes the number of buildings, the number of units, and whether the policy covers the entire grounds or just the inside of the building.

The “**Apartment-Condo-Public Housing**” database is designed to collect the names and addresses of all multi-unit dwellings. The database currently has more than 5,300 contacts that include: Apartments; Condominiums; Town Homes, Section 8 Housing; Senior Apartments and Senior Care Buildings; Property Management Firms; and Homeowner Associations. The “**Housing Contacts**” database currently has more than 400 contacts that include: Housing Authorities; Landlord and Tenant Associations; Apartment Finder Agencies; Government Agencies; Nonprofits; Coalitions; Real Estate Schools; Real Estate Boards and Associations; Media, and Trade Groups.
